



Sick Child Policy

In order to help eliminate the spread of colds, flu and other childhood sicknesses, we request that everyone in Christ Church children's programs abide by the following policy.

Please keep your child at home if any one of the following are true:

1. Your child has or has had a fever, vomited or had diarrhea in the past 24 hours
2. Your child has any facial secretions that are not clear (eyes, nose) or "crusty" discharge from nose or eyes
3. Your child has been coughing frequently
4. Your child has an undiagnosed or unexplained rash

*A child will not be admitted into children's programs with any of the above symptoms.

Occasionally, a child may develop symptoms of illness while in our care.

If any of the following symptoms appear, the caregiver will text the parent or guardian and request that the child is taken home for his or her own comfort and health as well as for the health and safety of the other children in our care:

- Particular fussiness
- Crying for more than 10 minutes
- Crying continually as if in pain
- Lethargic appearance
- Flushed face or sudden rash
- Cough frequently and sounds very congested
- Discharge from the eyes or nose that is not clear in color
- Overly warm to the touch

We sanitizes and disinfects all toys and surfaces, in all nurseries and classrooms, each time they are used.
